

How is the labour structure in countries?

Labour chapters ordered by value to employees

The tables below show the top-20 and down-20 GDP chapters in countries in terms of GDP / chapter & capita. Working in sectors K, J or L in Luxembourg, Norway, Denmark, Ireland or France seem very convenient. Besides, working especially in sector A in Turkey, Greece, Poland, Slovenia, Portugal, Austria, Lithuania, Hungary, Spain or Ireland is generating very low wages. Some figures though are too low; a potential interpretation could relate to seasonal and very low wages paid to employees, e.g. fruits or vegetables - to be confirmed. E.g. chapter A for Turkey: GDP 44874 mio USD and GDP for employees 2335 mid USD, in an employed population of 5295825 persons in 2018.
